The Mobile Area Dental Society will sponsor its first *continuing education* course for the 2009-10 year on Friday, September 25, 2009 at the Battle House Hotel. Ken Tilashalski, D.M.D., will present on Infection Control (2 hrs.) and Oral Diagnosis (4 hrs.).

Dr. Ken Tilashalski (Dr. "T") received his dental degree from the Southern Illinois University School of Dental Medicine. He completed residencies in both Oral & Maxillofacial Pathology and in Endodontics at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral & Maxillofacial Pathology. Dr. Tilashalski holds appointments as an Associate Professor in the Department of Diagnostic Sciences at the School of Dentistry and the Department of Pathology at the School of Medicine. While his research interests are varied, Dr. T's most recent works have involved the areas of harm reduction in smoking cessation and endodontic treatment outcomes.

Morning Session

Course Description: Infection Control

In a presentation appropriate for the entire staff, Dr. "T" will take you on an entertaining journey encompassing many facets of infectious diseases. Specific pathogens and diseases will be presented. Emphasis will be placed on immunizations and other ways to reduce infection and transmission. Numerous clinical examples will be shown, and the latest treatment recommendations of frequently seen infections will be highlighted.

This session fulfills the education and training requirements for Alabama dental and dental hygiene licensure in the area of infectious disease control.

Afternoon Session

Course Description: Oral Pathology

In the afternoon, the focus will be on clinical oral pathology. Emphasis will be placed on recognition and management of oral diseases that you are likely to see in your practice. The goal is to provide practical clinical information so participants will be able to recognize, diagnose and treat common oral conditions.
